Clay Man Charged With Causing Serious Injuries to Infant

Town of Clay, New York – The Onondaga County Sheriff's Office reports that a Town of Clay man has been charged in connection with causing serious injuries to his infant daughter.

Brian Wilson (40) of 4028 Bonstead Road, Clay, brought his nine month old daughter to Rochester's Strong Memorial Hospital Monday afternoon after the infant displayed signs of distress. Doctors, who medically evaluated the infant, discovered the infant suffered from a severe hemorrhage to the brain along with other injuries.

Hospital staff immediately notified Child Protective Service who notified Sheriff's Detectives with the Abused Persons Unit. An investigation conducted by Detectives revealed that Wilson caused his daughter's injuries while at the Bonstead Road home. She remains in critical condition in the intensive care unit at Strong Memorial Hospital.



Detectives charged Wilson with Reckless Assault of a Child and Endangering the Welfare of a Child. He was arraigned in the Town of Clay Court last night by Judge Gosch, who denied Wilson bail due to his prior felony convictions. Wilson is due back in court on November 14th.
