Two Charged in Connection with DeWitt Shooting

Town of DeWitt, New York –The Onondaga County Sheriff's Office reports that two people have been charged in connection with Monday evening's shooting incident that took place in a parking lot of the Springfield Garden Apartment complex.

After an aggressive investigation along with information developed by detectives, two teenagers have been charged with Attempted Murder in the 2nd degree and Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2nd degree.

Isaiah Outley (16) of 212 Delray Ave Syracuse and a 15 year old male juvenile were arrested late yesterday evening in connection with the shooting that took place on Monday as a sheriff's detective assigned to the Sheriff's Office Special Investigations Unit was conducting a drug investigation in the parking lot of the Springfield Garden Apartments. The two teenagers are accused of approaching the detective's unmarked vehicles and opening fire on the detective, nearly striking him as sat in the driver's seat. After firing multiple shots at the vehicle, Outley and the 15 year old juvenile, whose name is being withheld due to his age, fled on foot southbound through the parking lot.

Outley was arraigned this afternoon in the Town of DeWitt Court before Judge Gideon who set bail at \$250,000 cash or bond. The 15 year old juvenile was arraigned last night in the Town of DeWitt and is currently being held at the Hillbrook Juvenile Detention Center on bail set at \$250,000 cash or bond.

The intended target of the drug investigation, Jose Marcano (31) of 22 Caton Drive, was arrested Monday night and charged with Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the 3rd degree, Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 3rd degree and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 7th degree. He

was arraigned Tuesday afternoon in the Town of Salina Court before Judge Piraino who set bail at \$50,000 cash \$100,000 bond.

Detectives have recovered two handguns, which are believed to have been used in the shooting however a forensic firearm examination is pending.

The incident continues to remain under investigation.
