## **Deputies Identify Body Found Last Week at Liverpool Recycling Plant**

**Town of Clay, New York** – The Onondaga County Sheriff's Office has identified the man whose body was discovered last week at a recycling plant in the Town of Clay.

Sheriff's Detectives investigating the death of man, whose body was discovered last week at the Waste Management Recycling Plant on Steelway Blvd South, have identified the man as 25 year old Christopher Azzara of Cicero. Sheriff's Deputies were called to the recycling plant on Friday after an employee discovered a body inside a bale of recyclable material. Deputies investigating the incident at the time said the man appeared to be between the ages of 25 to 40.

An autopsy conducted by the Onondaga County Medical Examiner's Office determined that Azzara died from multiple blunt force crushing injuries. Detectives continue to investigate the incident, which appears to be non-criminal in nature.
