School Administrator Charged with Sex Crime

Town of Clay, New York – The Onondaga County Sheriff's Office reports that Sheriff's Detectives have charged a Town of Clay man this afternoon after he allegedly had sexual contact with a child less than 17 years of age.

Mark Trabucco (40) of Birchwood Road, Clay, a principal with the Adirondack Central School District in Boonville NY, was charged with two counts of criminal sex act in the 3rd degree and endangering the welfare of a child. Trabucco is accused of engaging in conversation through the classified advertisement website Craigslist, where arrangements were made to meet the victim, who is not a student of the Adirondack Central School District. The investigation into Trabucco began Thursday when the child reported the incident to a family member.



Trabucco was arraigned in the Town of Clay Court this afternoon before Judge Gosch, who released him on his own recognizance. The case has been waived to Grand Jury.

Detectives continue to investigate the incident and urge the public to call the Abused Persons Unit with any information by dialing 315-435-3092.
