Parolee Charged with DWI after Fleeing from Deputy

City of Syracuse, New York-The Onondaga County Sheriff's Office reports that a Madison County man has been charged with DWI after crashing his vehicle while trying to flee from a deputy.

On May 3rd, at approximately 12:45 am, a sheriff's deputy on routine patrol in the 3700 block of James Street observed a red Chevy trailblazer operating erratically as the driver turned onto East Milford Street. As the deputy attempted to initiate a traffic stop on the Trailblazer, the driver accelerated the vehicle in excess of the 30 mph City of Syracuse posted speed limit and refused to pull over for several blocks before crashing into a small tree and a parked Honda CRV on Northcliffe Road.

The driver fled on foot as the Trailblazer slowly continued onto Nichols Ave where it came to rest on the sidewalk. Additional deputies arrived in the area and began searching for the driver who was quickly located and taken into custody after a brief foot chase.

The driver, who was the sole occupant of the Trailblazer, was identified as Corey Carbery (25) of Woodgate Road, Chittenango. Carbery was charged with felony driving while intoxicated, aggravated unlicensed operation in the 1st degree, reckless driving, unlawful fleeing a police officer in the 3rd degree and was issued several traffic tickets.

Carbery, who is currently on parole, was arraigned in Syracuse City Court and is being held in the Onondaga County Justice Center without bail.
