Two Charged with Theft of Fright Nights Tickets

Town of Clay, New York – The Onondaga County Sheriff's Office reports that Sheriff's Detectives have charged two people in connection with the theft of Fright Nights tickets.

On Saturday October 7th, operator of Fright Nights, Grazi Zazzara, contacted deputies after discovering two separate ticket sale ads on Graigslist and Facebook. After making arrangements to meet the sellers, deputies learned that the tickets were recently stolen from a recycling plant in the Town of Clay where they were sent to be destroyed. Subsequent investigations conducted by detectives, two employees of the recycling plant were charged this morning in connection with the theft of the tickets.

Detectives charged Matthew Euson (46) of Terrace Street, East Syracuse, with petit larceny and criminal possession of a forged instrument in the 3rd degree. His coworker, Tiqinn Simpkins Daley (26) of North Salina Street, Syracuse, was charged with criminal possession of stolen property in the 4th degree and forgery in the 3rd degree. The two are accused of removing several sheets of tickets from a conveyer belt prior to destruction and cutting them into individual stubs with the intent to sell them.

Both men were released on appearance tickets and are expected to appear in court at a later date.
