## **Woman Remains in Critical Condition after being Struck by Vehicle on Interstate 81**

**Town of Salina, New York** – The Onondaga County Sheriff's Office investigated a serious crash yesterday evening on Interstate 81 near Mattydale that critically injured a woman.

Yesterday evening at approximately 6:35 pm, Sheriff's Deputies along with members from the New York State Police, responded to the northbound lanes of Interstate 81 near the Mattydale exit for a collision involving a motor vehicle and a pedestrian. Deputies who investigated the collision report that a 2014 Cadillac being operated by 49 year old Ralph Lowe of Boynton Beach, Florida was travelling northbound on 81 when he lost control of the vehicle and struck a concrete barrier. Lowe's passenger, 40 year old Adrienne Williams, also of Boynton Beach, Florida, exited the vehicle to remove the snow from the rear window when she was struck by a 2011 Chevrolet sedan, which had also been travelling northbound.

Williams suffered multiple injuries and was transported to Upstate University Hospital where she was listed in critical condition as of late last night. The driver of the Chevrolet, who was also injured, was identified as Jared Domer (31) of Cicero. Domer sustained facial injuries and was transported to Upstate University Hospital. Lowe and two children in the backseat of his vehicle were not injured.

The northbound lanes of Interstate 81 between Seventh North Street and the Mattydale exit were closed for several hours while members of the Sheriff's Accident Investigation Team reconstruct the accident.

Deputies say the weather and slippery road conditions contributed to the first collision. No tickets were issued.
