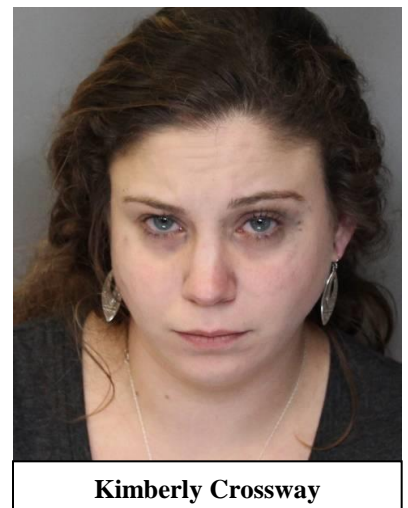

## Woman Charged in Hit and Run that seriously injured Pedestrian over the Summer

**Town of Onondaga, New York** – The Onondaga County Sheriff's Office reports that deputies have charged the driver of a vehicle that was involved in a hit and run that seriously injured a pedestrian on McDonald Road in the Town of Onondaga back in August.

After conducting a thorough investigation into the hit and run that left an adult female pedestrian with serious injuries, deputies have charged the woman accused of driving the vehicle that left the scene. Kimberly Crossway (29) of Marcellus, was charged last evening with leaving the scene of a personal injury accident, moving from lane unsafely and operating a mobile device.

Deputies report that on August 17<sup>th</sup>, Crossway was traveling westbound on McDonald Road near Velasko Road in her 2005 Jeep Cherokee, when her vehicle veered onto the shoulder of the road and struck pedestrian Takiya Williams (41) of Syracuse, who had been walking along the road. Williams sustained multiple injuries that day and was transported to Upstate University Hospital. She has since been released from the hospital, but continues to recover for her injuries.
