## Early Morning Fire Destroys Home

**Town of Salina, New York** – The Onondaga County Sheriff's Office investigated a structure fire this morning in the Town of Salina, which caused extensive damage to a home and left the residents homeless.

At approximately 7:30 am this morning, Sheriff's Deputies along with firefighters from Mattydale, Hinsdale, Liverpool, Moyers Corners, and East Syracuse responded to a reported structure fire at 100 Harrington Street in Mattydale. One of the occupants, Damian Barrios (27), discovered the fire at the front of the house near the porch and was able to call 911 and alert the other members of the family who were able to escape. Additional family members that were in the home were homeowner Mary Barrios, Josh Barrios (25), Jessica Hamilton (25), Samaria Barrios (3), and Amie Barrios (4 days old).



As crews arrived heavy smoke and flames were seen coming from the house. A section of Route 11 in Mattydale was closed while firefighters attempted to get the fire under control. Route 11 was re-opened at approximately 10:00 am.

Damian Barrios sustained minor burns to his hands when he attempted to extinguish the fire. He was transported to Upstate Hospital for evaluation. Josh Barrios sustained some cuts to his feet which occurred when he was trying to exit the residence. No other injuries were reported.

The Onondaga County Fire Investigators were called to the scene to investigate the cause of the fire, which is undetermined at this time. The American Red Cross was also on scene to assist the family.
