15-Year-Old Juvenile Arrested for School Violence Threat

Town of Clay, New York – The Onondaga County Sheriff's Office reports that Sheriff's Deputies have charged a 15- year-old juvenile after allegedly threatening school violence.

At approximately 8:36 am this morning, a School Resource Officer assigned to the North Syracuse Junior High School received information from concerned students about a potential school shooting after a classmate made statements to carry out acts of violence against the students and staff at the school. As a result of the investigation, a 15-year-old juvenile was arrested for Making a Terroristic Threat and was issued an Onondaga County Family Court appearance ticket. The school district has also taken appropriate disciplinary action. The name of the juvenile will not be released due to their age.

The Sheriff's Office will continue to work closely with school officials to ensure that students, teachers and staff in the North Syracuse Central School District have a safe environment.
