Student Charged with Making Terroristic Threat

Town of Cicero, New York – The Onondaga County Sheriff's Office reports that Sheriff's Deputies have charged an 18- year-old student after allegedly threatening school violence.

This afternoon at approximately 12:10 pm, a School Resource Officer assigned to the Cicero-North Syracuse High School received information from concerned students about a potential school shooting after a classmate made statements to carry out acts of violence against the students and staff at the school. As a result of the investigation, deputies charged Cameron Mott (18) of North Syracuse, with making a terroristic threat. Mott, who is scheduled to be arraigned this evening in Central Court, is currently being held in the Justice Center.

The school district has also taken appropriate disciplinary action. The Sheriff's Office will continue to work closely with school officials to ensure that students, teachers and staff in the North Syracuse Central School District have a safe environment.
