Man in Critical Condition After being struck by Vehicle

Town of Lysander, New York – The Onondaga County Sheriff's Office is currently investigating an accident involving a vehicle that struck a pedestrian last night on Route 31 in front of the CountryMax store, which has left the pedestrian in critical condition.

Last night at approximately 11:19 p.m., Sheriff's Deputies along with rescue personnel from the Belgium Cold Springs Fire Department responded to Route 31 between Willett Parkway and the Baldwinsville Bypass for a reported accident involving a pick-up truck that struck a pedestrian. When Deputies arrived on scene they discovered an unconscious adult male in the road with severe injuries. The victim, who was identified as 27 year old Donald Milazzo of Baldwinsville, was quickly transported to Upstate University Hospital where he underwent emergency surgery and is currently listed in critical condition. Deputies investigating the accident state that the victim appeared to have been walking in the westbound lane when he was struck by a 2011 Nissan pick-up that was traveling westbound. The driver of the Nissan, Ryan Ziparo (29) also of Baldwinsville, was not injured in the accident and is cooperating with deputies as they continue to investigate the facts and circumstances surrounding the accident.

Route 31 between Willett Parkway and the Baldwinsville Bypass was closed for several hours while members of the Sheriff's Accident Investigation Team processed the scene. The road has since reopened.

The accident remains under investigation and no tickets have been issued.
