Two Juveniles Charged in Armed Robbery of Convenience Store

Town of Onondaga, New York-The Onondaga County Sheriff's Office reports that Sheriff's Detectives have charged two juveniles in connection with the robbery of a convenience store that occurred last Friday.

After an extensive investigation, along with the assistance from the Syracuse Police Department, detectives have arrested two juveniles in connection with the November 2nd robbery of the Speedway convenience store located 6020 South Salina Street in the Town of Onondaga. Detectives say the two juveniles, who are 15 and 16 years of age and both of Syracuse, are accused of entering the store at approximately 12:11 am and brandishing what appeared to be a firearm at an employee while demanding money from the cash register. After committing the robbery, both juveniles fled from the store in a northbound direction with an undisclosed amount of cash and lottery tickets.

The juveniles were charged this afternoon with robbery in the 1st degree and criminal use of a firearm in the 1st degree. The juveniles were arraigned in County Youth Court and are currently being held at the Hillbrook Detection Center on separate bail amounts, \$50,000 cash/bond and \$25,000 cash/\$50,000 bond.
