Sheriff's Office & Geddes Police Investigate Motor Vehicle Accident that Claims the Life of an Oswego County Woman

Town of Geddes, New York-The Onondaga County Sheriff's Office and the Town of Geddes Police Department continue to investigate a motor vehicle accident that occurred last night in the Town of Geddes that has claimed the life of an Oswego County woman.

Last night at approximately 10:48 pm, Sheriff's Deputies along with members of the Geddes Police Department responded to the westbound lanes of Interstate 690 near exit 7 (Fairgrounds Exit) in the Town of Geddes for a reported serious motor vehicle collision. The two agencies investigating the collision report that a 2006 Ford Fusion operated by a Megan Sundberg (22) of Fulton, was traveling westbound on 690 when her vehicle struck the guardrail and became disabled facing eastbound in the far left lane. A second collision occurred moments after when another westbound vehicle, a 2012 Chevrolet Tahoe operated by Matthew Bruce (42) and his passenger Alexis Bruce (41) both of Camillus, struck the Fusion head-on. A third vehicle, a 2014 Mercedes Benz operated by a Jordan Leet (28) of Camillus, was also involved in the second collision.

The collision shutdown westbound 690 between the Geddes Street off ramp and the fairgrounds exit for several hours while members of the Sheriff's Office Accident Investigations Team processed the scene.

Sundberg was transported to Upstate University Hospital where she died from her injuries shortly before 7:00 am this morning. Matthew and Alexis Bruce both sustained minor injuries and were transported to Upstate University Hospital. Leet sustained minor injuries and was transported to Crouse Hospital.

The Sheriff's Office and the Geddes Police Department were also assisted by New York State Police, Solvay Police, Solvay Fire Department and AMR Ambulance.

The investigation into the cause of the first collision is on-going at this time. No tickets have been issued.
