Deputies Investigate Armed Robbery

Town of Salina, New York-The Onondaga County Sheriff's Office is currently investigating an armed robbery of a Dunkin Donuts that occurred yesterday evening in the Town of Salina.

On November 25th, at approximately 9:53 pm, deputies responded to an armed robbery that just occurred at the Dunkin Donuts located inside the Express Mart at 2723 Brewerton Road. Deputies investigating the incident say the suspect, who was wearing a gray hoodie sweatshirt with dark pants, entered the Dunkin Donuts armed with an unknown type handgun and demanded money from an employee. The suspect immediately fled from the store after taking an undisclosed amount of money and was last seen getting in a white colored Chevrolet Malibu vehicle before it exited the parking lot. No injuries were reported.



Detectives assigned to the Sheriff's Criminal Investigation Division, responded to the scene and interviewed witnesses, who described the suspect as a light skinned male, possibly black or Hispanic, in his late teens to early 20's, standing approximately 5' 7" tall, with a thin build. The suspect vehicle, which was reported stolen, was later discovered abandoned by the Syracuse Police Department on Culbert Avenue in the city of Syracuse.

Additionally, members of the New York State Police investigated a similar robbery that occurred less than an hour earlier at the Gulf Gas Station located at 2300 Court Street.
