Qualifications

On the date of examination:

- Must be at least 19 yrs. 6 mos. of age on or before (not eligible if 35 years of age or older, unless there is qualifying military duty)
- Must have resided in the U.S. or one of its territories for not less than one month immediately preceding the date of exam
- Must be a citizen of the United States

On the date of appointment:

- Must be 20 years of age
- Must be a resident of Onondaga County or any adjoining county
- Must be a high school graduate, possess a GED, or possess a U.S. Armed Forces General Education Certificate
- Must possess a valid New York State Driver's License

Special Necessary Requirements:

- Must meet the prescribed general physical conditions as stated in the Municipal Police Training Council Standards
- No conviction of a felony (Conviction of a misdemeanor may bar appointment)
- Psychiatric and polygraph examination may be required of any successful candidate prior to appointment
- Successful completion of the New York State Municipal Training Council and Onondaga County Sheriff's Office Training and Evaluation Program
