Driver Charged with DWI after Crash on Oswego Road

Town of Clay, New York – The Onondaga County Sheriff's Office reports that Sheriff's Deputies have charged a Town of Clay man with DWI after he crashes his vehicle into a utility pole and two parked vehicles last night.

Yesterday evening at approximately 8:30 p.m., sheriff's deputies responded to a motor vehicle crash on Oswego Road near Gaskin Road, which involved a vehicle that struck a utility pole and two parked vehicles. Deputies investigating the crash say the driver of a 2012 Volkswagen SUV, identified as David Oakley (48) of Clay, had been traveling south on Oswego Road when he lost control of his vehicle and drove off the road striking a utility pole and two parked unoccupied vehicles before his SUV came to rest in the drive of 8717 Oswego Road.

The impact from the collision caused significant damage to all three vehicles and sheared the utility pole in half bringing wires down. Oakley sustained a minor facial injury in the crash and was determined to be intoxicated. Oakley was transported to Upstate University Hospital for his injuries and was charged with driving while intoxicated and speeding.

Oakley has been released and is expected to appear before a judge in the Town of Clay Court at a later date.

Oswego Road between Gaskin Road and Verplank Road was closed for several hours while crews from National Grid made repairs. The road has since reopened.
