Suspect Quickly Taken into Custody after Robbery Attempt

Town of Onondaga, New York – The Onondaga County Sheriff's Office reports that a Syracuse man has been charged with attempted robbery of the Dunkin Donuts this afternoon in the Town of Onondaga.

Today at approximately 12:16 PM, sheriff's deputies responded to the Dunkin Donuts located at 4886 West Seneca Turnpike for a robbery in progress. Deputies investigating the incident say the suspect, later identified as 22-year-old Nathan Kane of Syracuse, walked into the donut shop and demanded money from the employees. After refusing to give Kane money, he fled from the establishment but was quickly spotted running behind a nearby business by an arriving deputy. No injuries were reported and Kane was taken into custody without further incident.

Kane has been charged with attempted robbery in the 3rd degree and is expected to be arraigned this evening in Centralized Arraignment Court.
