## Man Dies in Custody on Way to Hospital

**Town of Onondaga, New York** – The Onondaga County Sheriff's Office is investigating the death of a man who was placed into custody after becoming physically combative with first responders who were attempting to provide medical treatment.

On Tuesday morning at approximately 6:18 A.M., rescue personnel from TLC ambulance along with Sheriff's Deputies responded to a residence in the 200 block of Hudson Avenue in the Town of Onondaga for an ambulance call regarding an unconscious 36-year-old male. Upon the arrival of medical personnel, they discovered the male was still unconscious. Medical personnel immediately administered the drug Naloxone and within seconds the male regained consciousness but became physically combative, striking and kicking the medical personnel and a sheriff's deputy. The male quickly exited the residence and became increasingly aggressive towards personnel before going unconscious again. For the safety of the male and personnel on scene, the male was placed in handcuffs and transferred to a stretcher so medical personnel could continue to provide the necessary treatment. The male was placed in the ambulance and while being transported to Upstate Community Hospital the male went into cardiac arrest.

The male, identified as Daniel Gibson of Nedrow, was pronounced dead a short time later at the hospital.

The New York State Attorney General's Office has been notified and has assumed case responsibility.
