## Deputies Make Arrest in Stabbing Incident

**Town of Van Buren, New York** – The Onondaga County Sheriff's Office has charged three people in connection with a stabbing incident that took place this week on school grounds in the Baldwinsville School District.

On December 15<sup>th</sup>, at approximately 1:30 am, Sheriff's Deputies responded to Crouse Hospital to investigate a stabbing that occurred to a 16-year-old male who had arrived at the facility for medical treatment. Upon interviewing the victim, he indicated that the incident took place around 12:15 A.M. on the grounds of the McNamara Elementary School off Obrien Road. The victim made prior arrangements to meet one of his assailants at the school to engage in a physical altercation. During the altercation, two other assailants joined in at which time the victim was stabbed with a knife at the base of his neck. The three assailants fled from the scene and the victim was transported to Crouse Hospital by private vehicle. The victim is in stable condition and is expected to survive.

Detectives assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division along with School Resource Officers, quickly developed suspects information and as a result of the investigation, the following individuals were charged:

**Jaimere Moore (19)** of Baldwinsville was charged with Gang Assault in the 2<sup>nd</sup> degree and Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 4<sup>th</sup> degree. Moore was arraigned on December 17<sup>th</sup> and is currently being held in the Justice Center on bail set at \$25,000 cash or \$50,000 bond.

**14-year-old male juvenile** of Baldwinsville was charged with Gang Assault in the 2 degree. He was issued an appearance ticket.

**16-year-old male juvenile** of Baldwinsville was charged with Gang Assault in the 2<sup>nd</sup> degree and criminal possession of a weapon in the 2<sup>nd</sup> degree. He was remanded at the Hillbook Detention Facility.
