Deputies Investigate Serious Crash on Buckley Road

Town of Clay, New York – The Onondaga County Sheriff's Office is currently investigating a serious crash that occurred early this morning on Buckley Road in the Town of Clay.

This morning at approximately 12:52 A.M., sheriff's deputies along with rescue personnel responded to the 7300 block of Buckley Road between Waxwood Circle and Rita Drive for a serious crash involving two vehicles. Deputies investigating the crash report that the two vehicles, an Audi sedan and a Ford Explorer, were both traveling northbound on Buckley Road at a high rate of speed when both adult male operators lost control of their vehicles and collided with one another. Both vehicles left the east shoulder of the road where they struck a culvert, causing both vehicles to rollover.

The operator of the Audi and his two adult passengers sustained minor injuries in the crash. The operator of the Ford Explorer was discovered unconscious with a head injury and was transported to Upstate University Hospital where he is currently listed in serious but stable condition.

The operator of the Audi was identified as Kalid Baraw (20) of Syracuse was charged with driving while intoxicated, Operating a vehicle with a suspended registration and unlicensed operation. He was released on traffic tickets and is scheduled to appear in the Town of Clay Court on April 11th.

The driver of the Ford Explorer has not been identified at this time.

Members of the Sheriff's Office Accident Investigations Team along with Detective with the Criminal Investigations Division continue to investigate the crash.
