Deputies Investigating Hit and Run Involving Two Pedestrians

Town of Onondaga, New York – The Onondaga County Sheriff's Office is actively investigating a hit and run crash that occurred on Meredith Avenue in the Town of Onondaga, which has left a pedestrian in critical condition.

This afternoon at approximately 4:27 p.m., Sheriff's Deputies along with rescue personnel responded to the 100 block of Meredith Avenue for a reported hit and run involving two pedestrians. When Deputies arrived on scene they discovered a 24- year-old male on the side of road with significant injuries. The male was transported to Upstate University Hospital where he is currently listed in critical condition. Deputies investigating the crash state that the victim appeared to have been walking on the side of the road with another unidentified male when the two were struck from behind by a white SUV. The SUV, which should have noticeable front-end damage, continued eastbound on Meredith before turning south on South Salina Street towards the Onondaga Nation. The second pedestrian left the scene prior to deputies arriving.

The investigation is active and ongoing. Additional information will be released once it becomes available.
