Camillus Man Charged in Connection with Multiple Sex Crimes

Town of Camillus, New York – The Onondaga County Sheriff's Office reports that Sheriff's Detectives assigned to the Abused Persons Unit along with the assistance from the Camillus Police Department, have charged a Camillus man with multiple sex crimes.

Andrew Pinkett (20), of Camillus, was charged Thursday with the following:

Incident one

Use of a child in a sexual performance

Promoting a sexual performance by a child

Forcible touching

Sexual misconduct (two counts)

Endangering welfare of a child (two counts)

Pinkett is accused of engaging in sexual intercourse with a 16-year-old person and video recorded the incident via social media app without the knowledge and or consent of the victim.

Incident two

Criminal sex act in the 1st degree

Rape in the 3rd degree

Strangulation in the 2nd degree

Endangering welfare of a child (two counts)

Pinkett is accused of engaging in sexual intercourse with a 14-year-old child when he was 17 years old. The victim, who did not give consent to the sexual intercourse, was also strangled.

Incident three

Rape in the 1st degree

Sexual misconduct (two counts)

Endangering the welfare of a child

Pinkett is accused of engaging in forcible sexual intercourse with a 14-year-old child and subjecting the victim to sexual misconduct acts.

The investigation into Pinkett began when the victim's reported to family members, who contacted the Sheriff's Office and the Camillus Police Department. Pinkett was arraigned Thursday evening in Centralized Arraignment Court with bail set at \$100,000 cash \$200,000 bond on all three incidents. He is currently being held in the Justice Center and is due back in court on June 16th.
