Two Time Convicted Felon Faces Multiple Firearm Charges

Lafayette, New York – The Onondaga County Sheriff's Office reports that a Town of Tully man is facing multiple firearm charges following a domestic incident investigation.

On July 16th, at approximately 1:00 A.M., deputies responded to an address in the Town of Lafayette for a reported verbal domestic incident involving an adult male who was verbally threatening an adult female. During the course of the investigation, deputies discovered that the adult male, identified as Daniel Seils (37) of Tully, a two-time convicted felon possessed several guns inside the apartment.

Subsequent search of the apartment and Seils vehicle resulted in the recovery of a Ruger .40 Caliber handgun, a Taurus 9mm handgun, FNX 9mm handgun, a Phoenix Arms .22 caliber handgun and a Featherlight 12-gauge shotgun.

Three of the five guns did not have serial numbers and were determined to be manufactured via 3-D printer.

Seils was charged with the following:

criminal possession of a weapon in the 2nd degree (3-counts)

criminal possession of a weapon in the 3rd degree (3-counts)

criminal possession of a weapon in the 4th degree. (1-count)

criminal possession of a firearm (1-count)

Aggravated harassment in the 2nd degree

Seils, who has two previous convictions (CPCS 3rd and DWAI-Drugs) was arraigned on July 16th before a Judge who denied bail. Seils is currently being held in the Justice Center.
