Liverpool Woman Charged in Crash that Caused Serious Injuries to a Child

Town of Clay, New York- The Onondaga County Sheriff's Office reports that Detectives have charged a Liverpool woman in connection with last week's crash in the Town of Clay that seriously injured a 10-year-old child.

This morning, Sheriff's Detectives assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division arrested the operator of the Ford pickup truck, identified as Harley VanSlyke (39) of Liverpool. She was charged with vehicular assault in the 2nd degree, driving while intoxicated, aggravated driving while intoxicated, unreasonable speed and passing a red light. VanSlyke is currently being held in the Justice Center and is expected to be arraigned sometime today.

The 10-year-old child remains hospitalized in serious condition.

Previous Release- On September 17th, 2022, at approximately 9:44 pm, Sheriff Deputies responded to the intersection of Henry Clay Boulevard and Buckley Road in the Town of Clay, regarding a two-car crash. The investigation and witness interview determined the vehicle at fault, a white Ford F-150 pickup, was traveling north on Henry Clay Boulevard when it passed the red light at the intersection with Buckley Road. A blue colored Honda CRV was traveling east through the intersection when it was struck by the pickup. The operator of the CRV suffered minor injuries, however her 10-year-old daughter sustained serious injuries and was transported to Upstate University Hospital, where she was initially listed in critical condition. The female operator of the pickup along with her 8-year-old passenger were both transported to Upstate Hospital for an evaluation. The crash remains under investigation and no tickets have been issued at this time.
