Daughter Stabs Father During Domestic Dispute

Town of Salina, New York – The Onondaga County Sheriff's Office reports that a 30-year-old Lyncourt woman has been charged with assaulting her father after stabbing him with a knife during a domestic dispute.

On October 4th, at approximately 9:11 P.M., Sheriff's Deputies responded to a reported domestic with a weapon/stabbing that occurred in the 100 block of Marsden Road in the Town of Salina. Upon the arrival of deputies, they discovered a 50-year-old male laying on the front yard with a stab wound to his back. Deputies investigating the incident report that the daughter, identified as Paris Gardner (30), was intoxicated and argumentative with her brother and father. During the course of the argument, Gardner allegedly shattered a television and then retrieved a knife from the kitchen before stabbing her father once in the back with it. Deputies charged Gardner with assault in the 2nd degree and criminal possession of a weapon in the 3rd degree, menacing in the 2nd degree, criminal mischief in the 3rd degree and endangering the welfare of a child.

The 50-year-old victim was transported to Upstate Community Hospital and is expected to survive. Gardner was also transported to St. Joseph's Hospital for medical treatment consisting of a laceration to her forehead. She is expected to be arraigned later today.
