Detectives Identify Victim Killed in Town of Onondaga House Fire

Town of Onondaga, New York – The Onondaga County Sheriff's Office continues to investigate the cause of a house fire that claimed the life of a Town of Onondaga woman yesterday afternoon.

On October 22, 2022, at approximately 1:13 P.M., Sheriff's Deputies along with firefighters from the Taunton, Solvay, Fairmount and Lakeside Fire Departments responded to a reported house fire at 4040 Howlett Hill Road between Copperfield Road and Prairieview Drive in the Town of Onondaga. Upon the arrival of first responders, they discovered heavy smoke and flames coming from the residence. Firefighters entered the home where they quickly extinguished the fire and discovered the victim, 69-year-old Anne Prashaw, deceased on the first floor of the two-story home.



Detectives from the Criminal Investigations Division along with Onondaga County Fire Investigators continue to investigate the fire, which is confirmed to have started in the living room.
