Two Men Charged Following Drug Investigation

Onondaga County, New York-The Onondaga County Sheriff's Office reports that two men are facing drug charges following a lengthy investigation into a large-scale illegal marihuana trafficking operation in the CNY area.

Detectives assigned to the Sherriff's Office Special Investigations Unit, executed several search warrants yesterday in the Town of Salina and in the City of Fulton. As a result, two men were charged with numerous felonies and detectives recovered a large amount of drugs/marihuana, cash and seized three vehicles. Detectives executed search warrants at a Lorian Drive residence and a business in the Town of Salina as well as a residence on West 4th Street South in the City of Fulton, where they recovered a total of 168 pounds of marihuana, 1 pound of concentrated cannabis, 1.6 pounds of psilocybin mushrooms, \$138,455 in U.S. currency and seized three vehicles used in the transport and transaction of these drugs.



Donnelldo Madrid (33) of Liverpool, and Michael J. Queior (43) of Fulton, were both charged with conspiracy in the fourth degree, aggravated criminal sale of cannabis, criminal possession of cannabis in the first degree, criminal sale of cannabis in the second degree, criminal possession of a controlled substance in the fifth degree, and criminal possession of a controlled substance in the seventh degree.

Both men were arraigned today and released on pre-trial proceedings.

The investigation is **ongoing** at this time and additional arrests are expected.
